

Sokhna Port

APL now calls at the Sokhna port in Egypt via the Red Sea Express (REX) service. With the shift of vessel operations from Adabiya (AAB) to Sokhna (S8W), APL can provide customers faster and more efficient cargo service. This move is part of our continuous effort to serve your needs better and ensure you receive the high level of service you expect and deserve.

Features of Sokhna Port

- Located about 40 kilometres south of Suez on the Red Sea
- Distance from Adabiya to Sokhna is only 20 kilometres. Sokhna is located 130 kilometres east of Cairo.
- Built within the Suez Special Economic Zone (SSEZ) which is poised to become a major commercial and industrial area in Egypt
- To become the major port of the Suez Canal, serving the import and export needs of the SSEZ, south of Suez along the Red Sea, and the Greater Cairo region
- Connected to road and rail networks and has links to all inland points previously served via Adabiya
- Most modern and first automated port in Egypt across all departments, including marine operations, customs, security and information systems
- Has facilities to accommodate large container vessels of over 8,000 TEU
- First port in Egypt to be operated by the private sector, Sokhna Port Development Company (SPDC)
